INVESTOR RELATIONS

With growing demand for uncorrelated returns, Brummer & Partners strengthens its resources to continue nurturing and growing its client base. Jonas Börjesson and Carl-Johan Brodowsky will share responsibility for Investor Relations (IR) globally. Jonas Börjesson, with a background from i.a. Morgan Stanley, joined Brummer & Partners in 2008 and has been Head of IR since 2012. Carl-Johan Brodowsky returns to Brummer & Partners after four years at Keel Capital. With a team of 30 employees in Stockholm and London, they will increase focus towards investors who assess returns based on risk and responsibility while seeking diversification to their portfolios.

BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

BMS currently invests in and analyses nine underlying hedge fund strategies. This means more than 4,000 positions across over 300 markets. Heading the firm’s infrastructure and daily operations are Markus Wiklund and Henrik Paulsson. Markus Wiklund, Deputy CEO of BMS, has been with the firm since 1997 in various positions including being responsible for risk analysis and portfolio construction. Henrik Paulsson joined Brummer & Partners from Nasdaq OMX in 2010. He is the CEO of B & P Fund Services and is responsible for developing the in-house infrastructure comprised of 90 professionals who serve the group’s fund managers.

Patrik Brummer: “We would also like to thank our two outgoing partners Kent Janér and Per Josefsson who for many years have made valuable contributions to Brummer & Partners. They are no longer as active in the firm’s core business and the shift is a natural one.”

With an ongoing focus to improve and evolve, Brummer Multi-Strategy aims to add two new sector specialist long/short equity strategies in the autumn. The funds are currently in the process of receiving regulatory approval.
